

Memorandum of Agreement made this 1 day of January, 2021.

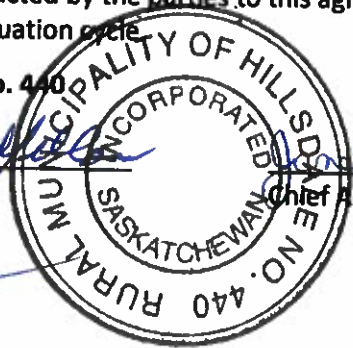
Between: **Rural Municipality of Hillsdale No. 440**
-and-
Little Pine First Nation

The parties agree together as follows:

1. The parties to this agreement agree that the Rural Municipality of Hillsdale No. 440 will provide fire protection services within the boundaries of the Rural Municipality of Hillsdale No. 440 and being an Indian Reserve of Little Pine First Nation.
2. The parties to this agreement agree that Little Pine First Nation will pay to the Rural Municipality of Hillsdale No. 440 the following sums for fire protection services as outlined above, namely:
 - a) **Annual Fee** – an annual fee of 0.77 mill on the SARM Taxable Assessment of Little Pine Reserve Land within the Rural Municipality of Hillsdale No. 440.
 - b) **Fire Suppression Services** – Schedule "A" to this agreement Neilburg Fire Board, Schedule "B" to this agreement Cut Knife & District Fire Association, Schedule "C" to this agreement Maidstone Waseca & District Fire Board.
3. In the event the subject fire commenced in the Rural Municipality of Hillsdale No. 440 and outside the boundaries of Little Pine First Nation, then the Rural Municipality of Hillsdale No. 440 will charge no sums to Little Pine First Nation for fighting such fire.
4. The Rural Municipality of Hillsdale No. 440 is to respond to requests to fight fires as described above in a timely manner.
5. The Rural Municipality of Hillsdale No. 440 is hereby granted access to Little Pine Reserve Lands to fight fire regardless of origin.
6. Other than for a breach of the within agreement, no action or other proceeding lies or shall be instituted against the Rural Municipality of Hillsdale No. 440, or a person assisting in firefighting for any loss or damage suffered by reason of anything in good faith done, caused, permitted or authorized to be done, attempted to be done or admitted to be done, by any of them, in the course of fire fighting under the within agreement.
7. It is understood and agreed that this agreement shall be in effect on a continuing basis commencing on execution of all parties, and may be terminated by either party by giving sixty (60) days notice in writing. It is further agreed that a review and update of the rate for the Annual Fee and the rates for Fire Suppression Services as outlined in Schedules "A", "B" and "C" will be conducted by the parties to this agreement at the end of 2024, and every fourth year thereafter based on a four (4) year revaluation cycle.
