BYLAW 3/2016

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR MILL RATE FACTORS

The Council for the Rural Municipality of Hillsdale No. 440 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The following mill rate factors shall be applied to the uniform mill rate levied against all taxable property for municipal purposes:

Agriculture 1.0500 Residential 1.0000 Commercial 9.0000

2. Bylaw 2, 2014 is hereby repealed.
